## SECTIONS

All sections are qualifying events for the UK Chess Challenge.

Under 9	Open to players who are eligible to enter the UKCC at U7, U8 and U9 age groups, who have not yet qualified for the Megafinal stage.
Under 11	Open to players who are eligible to enter the UKCC at U10 and U11 age groups, who have not yet qualified for the Megafinal stage.

Ages are those on the 1st of September in the previous year.

## TIME CONTROL

All games will be played with clocks, at the rate of 20 minutes each plus 5 seconds per move. Assistance will be given to any child unfamiliar with using chess clocks.

## SCORING

Players will be awarded 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 for a loss.

## PAIRINGS

Players will be paired in each section using a computerised Swiss system, which will be posted on <http://www.chess-results.com/> as well as at the venue. No discussion will be entered into concerning the pairings.

No player gets knocked out for losing a game, players are expected to play all rounds. If a player has to leave early, please tell the controllers.

## ARBITERS DECISIONS

All decisions of the arbiters are binding.

## RATING & GRADING

Games in this Last Chance Saloon will not be graded.

## VENUE & TRANSPORT

# The Delancey UK Chess Challenge



This is an annual chess competition for young people aged from under 7 through to under 18. Last year over 40 thousand took part. It runs in four stages, the first stage is a qualifying competition which takes part in the school or chess club, over seven weeks. The best girls and boys in each age group (U7, U7G, U8, U8G, etc.) qualify to take part in a local "Megafinal" in April or May. From there, the best players qualify in each age group, girls and boys to a regional "Gigafinal" in Reading in July and then potentially to a national "Terafinal" in August.

## Qualifying

In a change from previous years, those aged over can take part directly in the Megafinal of their choice. Meanwhile in the age groups, U7, U8, U9, 10 and U11, boys and girls can qualify through this Last Chance Saloon by finishing top in their age groups, or by scoring a minimum of 17 points.
